Home for Parents

To Stay or To Go:

- Parents are always welcome to stay in the lobby and watch class on the monitors. (Parents are also welcome to go to Target or Whole Foods conveniently located right down the street). :) Parents are not allowed in the studios unless invited by the teacher.
- Class Assistants or the Teacher will come to the lobby to line up the students at the start of class. Please give a quick "see you soon" in the lobby to your child and allow the class to walk independently down the hallway.
- Students will be dismissed back to the lobby directly to a grown up. Please let the front desk know if someone other than yourself is picking up your child.
- If you are running late for class, please have the front desk staff walk your child to the studio. In the dance culture, the studio door should not be opened while music is playing.
- **If your child is 7 or older, we highly encourage you to drop them off at the side door, watch them enter, and proceed around the building to keep the traffic moving during our busiest hours, 4:00-6:00**

Parking Lot Safety: Where to enter and exit.

- Traffic should be **ONE WAY ONLY** in the parking lot. Please enter the lot at the entrance **CLOSER to ANTONIO'S ONLY** and exit out the other driveway, closer to the townhouse complex.
- If dropping off, proceed to the side door, drop and keep going around the back of the lot to exit.
- If parking, please do so carefully.
- Our parking lot gets busy in between classes. We ask that you drive slowly and cautiously and follow these rules for the safety of all of the students and drivers.
- Please do not park along the building on the backside.

Performances:

Here at FNC we are a technique based studio. We value the opportunity to teach your kids “to dance,” versus teaching them “a dance,” “a song,” or “an act.” We believe that technique and the life lessons taught through the arts are of the utmost importance. We will begin work on our Year End Show during the second semester of our classes and the class structure will be maintained throughout the year. That being said, we LOVE to put on a show! We also recognize that not all children want to perform. All of our performing opportunities at the studio are open to all yet **OPTIONAL for My First, Pre-K, Intro, Hip Hop, Acro, and TD Level Classes.**

- **Year End Show: Sunday June 10th, 2017 Dress Rehearsal: Saturday June 9th, 2017**
This is the big one! Open to all FNC students who are enrolled in a group class. Costume purchases are required, one per class. Costume order letters will be given out in late October and are due back by **SUNDAY NOVEMBER 19th, 2017.** Each child will perform in one number per class and the Finale. **Students are required to stay backstage for the entire duration of the show, no early pick ups, no exceptions! One Dress Rehearsal is MANDATORY for participation in the show.** We thank you in advance for considering our policies when choosing the level of show participation for your child. All costumes are \$90 each and tickets are \$25-30 each in advance and purchased on line for a nominal fee. Tickets are required for all non-lap sitting audience members over 3 years old. More specific information to be given out with your costume order letters.
- **Voice Recital: Fall- Thursday December 7th, 2017 Spring- Thursday May 17th, 2018**
Open to all private voice students, our recitals are held once each semester in house or at a local venue pending the number of singers. There is a \$20 recital fee for participation and specific attire (from home) is required. One additional studio rehearsal is required to participate. Sign-ups happen approximately one month before each recital.
- **The Wiz: ENSEMBLE AUDITIONS: Saturday October 14th TECH WEEK and PERFORMANCES: Week of January 15th-January 21st**
Each year we work on one full scale musical in the fall and perform it in January. We call it the January musical! This year it is “The Wiz.” Ensemble Auditions are open to any FNC student in Kindergarten and up. There is a fee for participation and approximately 10 required Saturday rehearsals. Parents must purchase tickets to attend the show. This year’s show will be held at The Woodland in Maplewood. (The studio is closed for regular classes the week of the show and cast members are required to be at the theatre each night for tech rehearsal.)
- **ShowTime Performing Classes Perform at one competition and 2 Year End Shows**
Our regular ShowTime class with the added performance opportunity of attending one local competition in the Spring. All ShowTime Performing students are required to take a dance class in addition to their ShowTime class. Directors permission is required for all “Performing” classes. Please set up an appointment with Miss Renee if you are interested in finding out more. Showtime Performing classes will perform at one local competition the weekend of April 20-22. Please hold the entire weekend in your calendar. All Showtime Performing students will be required to purchase a minimum of 3 costumes (2 for Showtime class, 1 for their other dance class).
- **Musical Production Number: Performs in the Year End Show (one or two shows) and optional community events**
Each season we stage an elaborate 6 minute medley of a Broadway Show or Movie Musical. This opportunity is open to all students Kindergarten and up. There is a fee for participation and some additional rehearsals are required. This is an incredibly fun FNC tradition. I wonder what this year’s Production number will be?
- **The Daddy Daughter Dance Returns for 2018! Performs at the Year End Show: One Performance TBD**
The Dads are back! We loved watching the Moms and Sons dance last June too, but this season we are excited to invite the Dads to Dance with their daughters for the 2nd annual FNC Daddy Daughter Dance! No experience necessary. Some rehearsals required. More information available in the spring. (If a Dad is not available, we invite Grandpa or another family member to dance as well!)

My First and Pre-K Classes:

Story Time: We begin each class for our PK and My First classes with a dance or theatre related children's story. This time really helps the children transition from the outside world to the studio environment.

Potty Time: Please ensure that your child has used the bathroom before class begins. The class assistant is available to escort children to the bathroom during class, but it is less distracting for everyone if it is done before. All children in PK classes must be potty trained for class. If your child is not fully potty trained, her or she must take class in the My First level. A caregiver must stay in the lobby during class time in case there is the need for a diaper change.

Manners and My Best Beads: Please refer to the Dancers and Actors Manners in your Welcome Packet or on our website. These manners serve as a guideline for how we conduct ourselves at the studio and in our classes, for both students and parents. For our youngest students, we will emphasize only a few key manners such as keeping our hands to ourselves, not touching the barres, and listening while the teacher is talking. At the end of each class, each child who followed his or her manners and "did their very best", will be given a Best Bead on his/her string. If a child has not followed the manners, he or she will have been given a warning during the class and may not receive a bead. If this happens, the teacher will briefly speak to the parent or caregiver at the end of class. The child will have the opportunity to earn the bead back in the following week's class. Every child will receive a sticker or stamp on the hand or coloring sheet to take home. That sticker is to say thank you for "singing and dancing with us today". We find this system to be very effective in teaching proper classroom etiquette allowing us to maximize our class instructional and fun time!

Parent/Caregiver Participation: We encourage you to talk to your child about the work we are doing in class each week. Your child will come home with a sticker or a coloring sheet most weeks that relates to something we have been working on in class. This is meant to be a conversation starter between you and your child

Dance Bags: All children in Dance Combo and Rhythm and Roll should have a dance bag that comes into the studio with him or her. The teacher will let you know which pair of shoes to wear first. We recognize that dance shoes are an investment. Dance shoes should be worn in the studio only and never in the parking lot! Please help your child change into street shoes before leaving the studio. We ask that you **please label all shoes with your child's name.** We encourage you to keep an extra set of dance clothes in the bag of newly potty trained children. In case of an accident, extra dance clothes are available to borrow in the lobby in the drawers of pink bench.

Communicating with Teachers: We truly believe in open lines of communication at our studio. However, if you need to speak to your child's teacher or the director, please make an appointment at the front desk. Remember that the teacher has back-to-back classes and needs to get back into the studio for the next group of students. We ask that you respect this time and please do not try to have a conference directly before or after class. We will be happy to have the teacher call you back when he or she has time to devote his or her full attention to you. Parents should NEVER communicate directly with any FNC faculty member. All private lessons and rehearsals must be scheduled through the front desk.

NEW! Social Media Policy: Staff, Students, and Faculty

Use of Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, LinkedIn, blogging, and other online social media outlets is commonplace. We know that families have very different guidelines for their own children in terms of allowed social media access at a certain age. In an effort to allow our staff to maintain privacy and effective professional boundaries we have advised our staff to keep their social media private. Please use the front desk if you need to contact a teacher. FNC staff should not be directly contacted by parents or students.

Some More important Info to Read!

- **Our Faculty:** Our staff of highly experienced, professional performing artists and educators are specialists in their fields, some of whom travel from New York City. They have been carefully selected to lead our multi-faceted performing arts program. Our own Artistic Director, Renee Celeste, is a nationally and internationally recognized “Teacher’s Teacher” who has taught at the DanceLife Conference in Scottsdale, Arizona, The Dance Life Retreat Center in MA and for the Dance Studio Owner’s Association based in Australia. Encouraged by Miss Renee, the FNC faculty continues to expand their education by attending conferences and conventions such as Rhee Gold’s DanceLife Teacher Conference and Retreats, Dance Masters of America, New York City Dance Alliance, Alvin Ailey Teacher Training, Leap-’N-Learn Training, and The Dance Teacher Summit. The FNC staff is also very well trained from within our own community at the beginning of each season as well and throughout the year. We encourage you to peruse our teacher’s extensive biographies on our website, www.front-n-center.com.
- **Our Curriculums:** In addition to the Leap ‘N Learn Curriculum <http://leapnlearn.com/for-parents> our young children’s teachers are trained specifically on both of these curriculums. This season we will be incorporating the brand new T3: Training The Triple Threat Curriculum <http://t3trainingthetriplethreat.dance> into our ShowTime classes. We also incorporate The Rhythm Works Hip Hop Curriculum. We invite you to peruse our faculty bios on our website to learn more.
- **Registration Agreement and Payment:** Please ensure that you read and understand the terms and conditions on the back of your registration agreement, where your signature is required. Until we have obtained this signature, needed for both your safety and ours, the student will not actively be registered in the appropriate classes. We are happy to receive signed registration agreements in person, via mail, fax or email. In the event that your credit card or check fails to process, you will be assessed a \$25.00 fee.
- **Substitute Teacher Policy:** Front & Center is supportive of teachers with professional performing careers and understands that this may result in the need for instructor substitutions from time to time. Although we strive for continuity, we believe that professional work experience brings a unique perspective to teaching, and one that can only serve to benefit our students. As a result, should a regular teacher be unable to attend a class or lesson, another



highly qualified teacher will substitute on a short or long-term basis, encouraging versatility, flexibility and new learning experiences.

- **Rights and Reservations:** Front & Center reserves the right to alter or change class dates and times based upon scheduling needs. Low enrollment in a class may result in cancellation and/or consolidation with another class. Front & Center reserves the right to place students in age and level appropriate classes at their discretion.
- **Refunds and Changes to Your Schedule:** Please take note of our refund policy, printed on the back of your registration agreement and which you are required to sign prior to registration. Registration fees are non-refundable. If you choose to withdraw from a class within the first two weeks of the semester or the first applicable two weeks of class, a full refund minus the registration fee will be given. When registering for the full year, whether two half or one full year of classes, no refund will be given after the second week of the first semester has ended. All Costume orders are non-refundable for any reason.
- **Inclement Weather/Emergency Closings:** In the event of a snow day closing, information will be available on our voicemail, on our website, and via social media. F&C will make its own determination of closings independent of the school districts. Often conditions improve by the end of the day.
- **Missed and Make-Up Group Classes:** If Front & Center is open and you are unable to make it to a class, please do your best to call ahead of time so we can tell the teacher and attempt to schedule a make-up class. Any missed classes may be made up in any age and level appropriate class during that semester, space permitting. This is a great opportunity to try other classes in different disciplines! Please arrive early for all make-up classes and fill out a make-up coupon at the front desk.
- **Private Lessons:** Front & Center offers private voice lessons on a first-come first-served basis, pending studio and teacher availability. Private lessons are purchased in 14 week blocks on a particular day and time each week and must be used within the particular session purchased. Private lessons are non transferable between family members within a session or from one session to another. Lessons will be confirmed in our calendar and with the teacher when payment is received. Please read the Missed and Make- Up Private Lessons Policy when signing up for any private lessons. Trial lessons are offered at a rate of \$45. Lesson must be paid for before scheduling.
- **Missed and Make-Up Private Lessons:** Private lessons are sold in 14 week packages. Private lessons must be cancelled or rescheduled at least 24 hours in advance of the lesson, or the full amount for the lesson will be charged and no make-up lesson will be scheduled. It is your responsibility to reschedule this cancelled lesson. Students are only permitted to reschedule 2 of their 14 lessons per session and no refunds/credits will be given for any cancelled lessons over and above the 2. Should your teacher be unavailable for a scheduled lesson, the lesson may be rescheduled or may continue as planned with another teacher on staff. Should we need to reschedule the lesson due to teacher scheduling conflicts, you will be notified as soon as possible and we will make two attempts to reschedule. No missed lessons may be carried into the following semester or the summer.
- **Privacy Policy:** Any personal information collected by Front & Center, including addresses, emergency contact information, medical information, etc. is for internal use only. It will not be shared with any external organizations without your expressed consent.
- **Parent Appreciation Week:** Come on in and relax and enjoy free coffee and treats during parent appreciation week!
- **Bring-a-Friend Week:** We encourage you to bring your friends during these weeks held once each Fall and Spring. If your friend signs up for a class you can take advantage of our Refer-A-Friend Discount!
- **Monitors:** Parents will not be allowed to watch within the classroom, but the monitors will stay on during all classes, with the exception of costume week.
- **Credits:** Any credit in your account will be honored for 18 months from the date of issue. All credits are non-transferable and must be used by a student of the same household.
